PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT



Wave Soccer Club Inc. (WSC) is a soccer club that caters to all levels of play and offers high quality programs at both developmental and competitive levels of play and expects parents and family members to conduct themselves in a way that ensures a positive overall experience.

As a parent of a WSC Player, I/we will set a good example to my/our child in his/her soccer development by always adhering to the following WSC Parent Guidelines:

- I will give only positive feedback to players.
- I shall leave the coaching to the coach during the game and I will be supportive with positive feedback.
- I will not criticize the referee openly or directly, during or after games. Any criticism shall be done in writing, sent to my manager, coach or my club admin, not verbally.
- I will not criticize the coach openly or directly during or after games. Any criticism shall be done in writing and sent to the DOC, not verbally.
- I will not make negative comments about the game, coaches, referees, managers, players, or other parents at any time. I understand that this can be detrimental to our club community.
- I will cheer at all games within the spirit of fair play regardless of the game's outcome.
- I will do my best to have my child prepared for and in attendance at every game and practice. I will be on time or early when dropping off my child for a practice or game. If my child will miss a game or practice, I will communicate that fact with my coach as soon as possible so that they can make the necessary adjustments.
- I agree to pay team fees, in accordance with the budget set forth by the team manager and parents, according to the scheduled payment dates.
- I shall support the learning efforts of the players, coaches, and referees by demonstrating patience.
- I understand that improper behavior at a game, including but not limited to negative feedback to another parent on my child's team or the parents, players or fans of the opposing team, may result in a parent being asked to leave the field by the referee, coach, or a club official.
- I shall respect all WSC volunteers, including but not limited to team managers and Board members, remembering they are volunteering their time for the betterment of the team and club.
- I understand that if I violate this agreement, I will receive one warning in writing from WSC formally stating my violation. Upon a second violation, WSC may take disciplinary action up to and including banning parents from attending games, as well as any actions offered by Minnesota Youth Soccer Association (MYSA), or Twin Cities Soccer League (TCSL).
